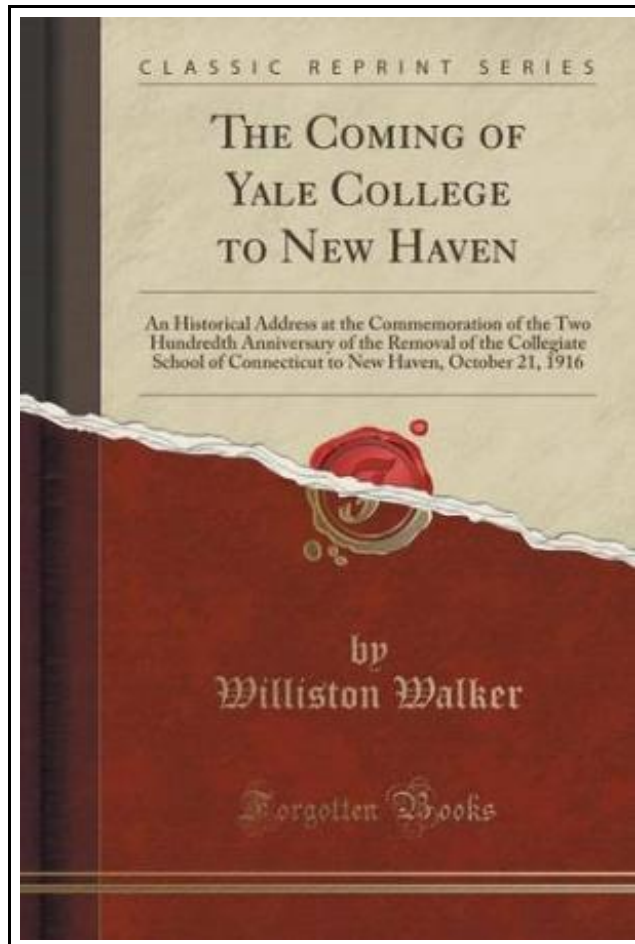



Rev. John Davenport, its chief spiritual leader, had urged such a foundation, probably as early as 1645, when New Haven was but in its infancy, in words prophetic of what Yale was to be, though used in this instance regarding the free school which was the immediate object of discussion. He would have a College: for the better training up of youth in this town, that through God's blessing, they may be fitted for public service hereafter, either in church or commonwealth. Nor was Davenport without support in this endeavor. The town of New Haven, as early as 1648, set aside land on what is now Elm Street, near the present. It was a site for the desired seat of learning. Four years earlier, efforts were made to enlist the aid of the little New Haven Colony in the undertaking. In 165, the General Court of the New Haven commonwealth had reason to believe that New Haven, besides its promised land, would contribute 300 for the foundation of a College, and that the other towns of the New Haven jurisdiction would raise the sum to 540. A few months later, Davenport was soliciting the assistance of that generous friend of education, Governor Edward Hopkins, of the Connecticut Colony, then returned to England, a...
