The Charters of Incorporation of the Fullers and Shearmen, therefore, precede in these pages those of the Clothworkers Company, and complete its corporate history. The first part of this book contains the Charters of Incorporation and the Inspeximus and Confirmation Charters; the second, the Grants of Lands, and also a Private Act of the fourth year of James I., confirming certain possessions to the several City Companies.
