The first point to aim at is the avoidance of syntactical errors; and to this end rules are available and useful. Experience shows that successive learners run through nearly the same round of mistakes, until one can predict, in any given piece, without much chance of failure, where the error will intrude. Still, in the main, the errors of those who have recently left the usual exercise books can be reduced to a few heads.
