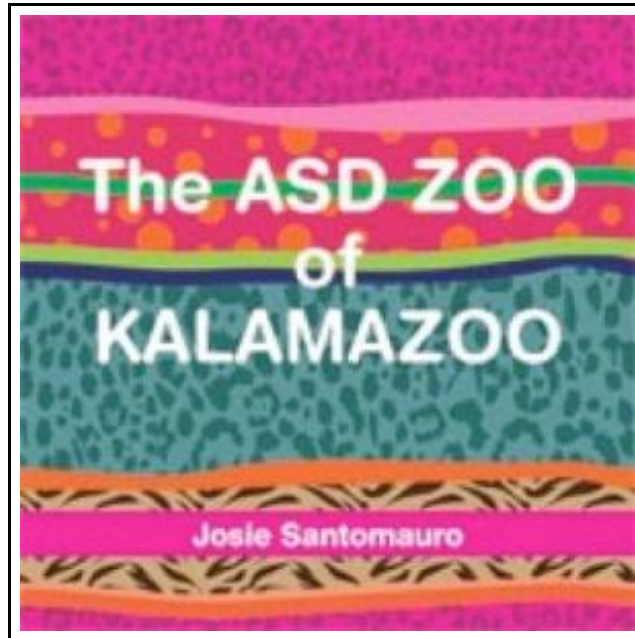

There is a special zoo in Kalamazoo and some of the animals have ASD, but they learn to live in harmony with the other social and neuro-typical animals. In the Kalamazoo Zoo there are a lot of animals that have ASD. How do these zoo animals handle their diagnosis, challenges and successes? They learn to live in harmony with the other social and neuro-typical animals. What a fun way to teach autistic spectrum disorders/Asperger through the eyes of animals, all different in their sizes, origins, color and demeanors.
